Keep it out of the Trash

All these items can be kept out of your trash—just follow the correct way to dispose listed below.

Aluminum Foil & Containers

– Gently wash and put in the blue recycle bin.

Batteries—rechargeable & lithium batteries are hazardous. Bring to an Eco-Depot collection or Radio Shack.

Boxes— All gift and shipping boxes can be recycled. Flatten and cut into 3 foot x 3 foot pieces. Bundle if you have a lot.

Cooking Oil—Smithfield DPW is collecting on Sat. Jan. 16th from 9 am—1 pm at 3 Spragueville Rd. Call 233-1034 x 105 for info.

Christmas Trees—Best is to compost, but if that is not an option, they can be dropped off at the Highway Garage during Jan. 2010. Can NOT be in plastic bags and must be free of tinsel and ornaments.



Clothing, Toys & Gear— Bring to collection with the RI Donation Exchange— see below.

Holiday Cards & Envelopes— Recycle in the green bin.

Old Electronics & Cell Phones—Bring to the Highway Garage.

Packing Peanuts— Bring to the UPS Store.

Plastic Bags— Recycle at local stores in the blue Restore Containers.

Styrofoam— Bring to the upcoming collection on Jan. 9th. See info below.

Wrapping Paper— Just flatten and put in the green recycle bin or in a paper bag. Do not put metallic paper, tissue paper or bows.
